Project Overview

What qualifies a facility as “regional”?

A facility that meets one or more of the following criteria:

- ✓ Multi-County Facility
- ✓ Connects to Regional Park or Preserve
- ✓ Connects to State/Federal Preserve or Park
- ✓ Connects to regionally-significant educational, cultural or historic facility
- ✓ Connects to downtown or CBD
- ✓ Connects to premium transit hub or stop
(e.g., Tri-Rail, MetroRail, Miami Busway)
