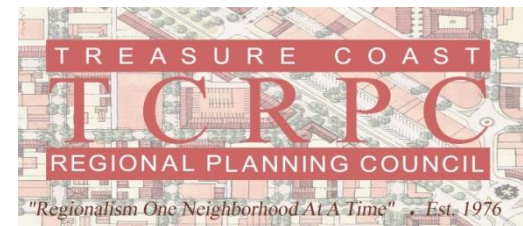

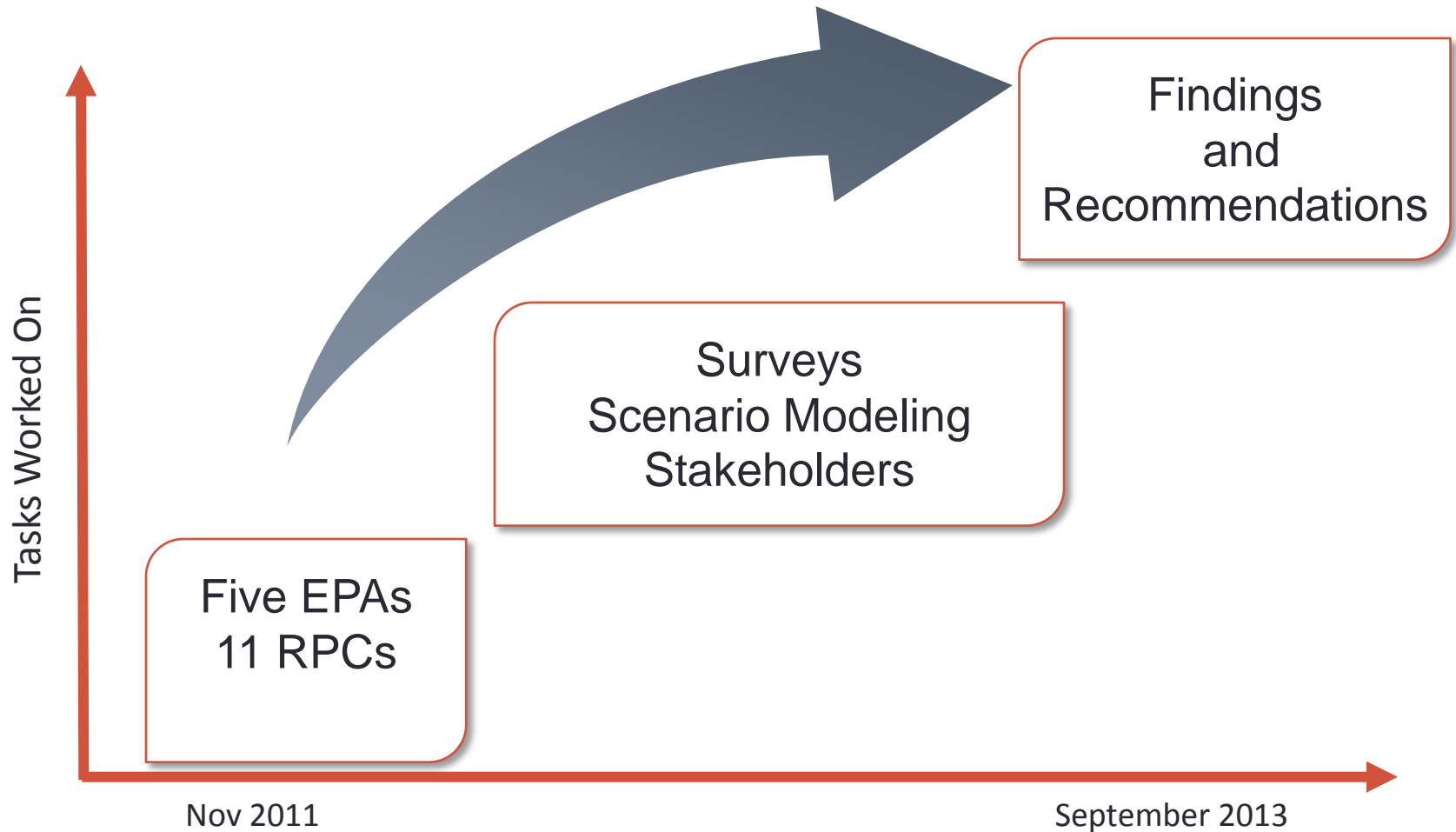

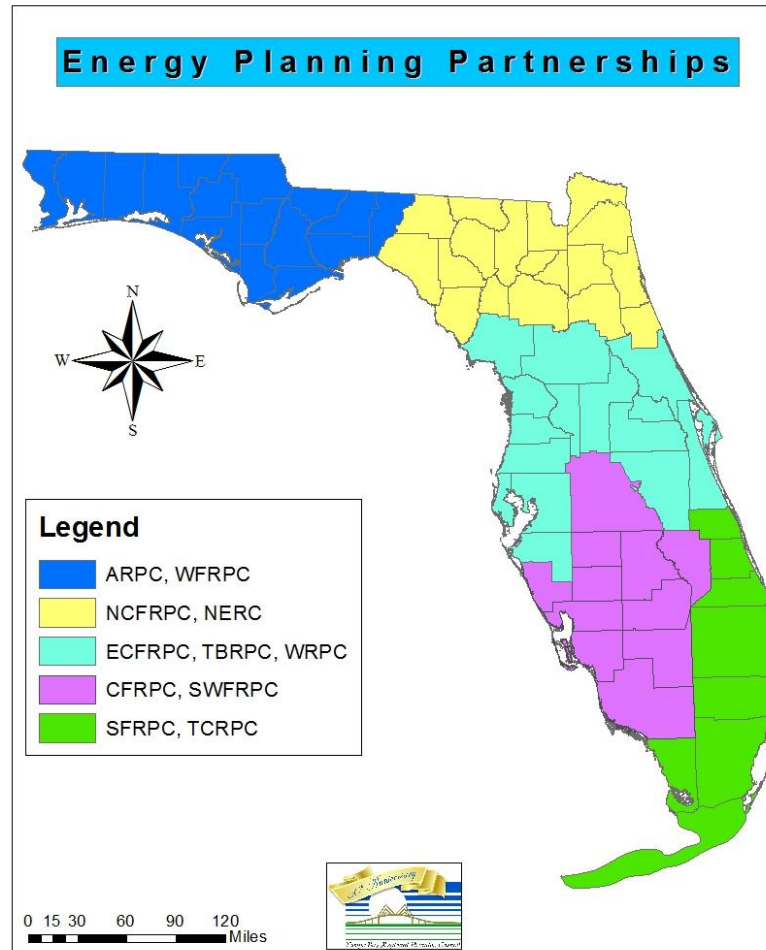
# Objectives of the Study
