

**Treasure Coast Regional Planning Council**  
**Summary of Council's Work Program**  
**FY 2020-2021**

- Implement the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the Three-Year grant for Council's Brownfields Assessment Grant Program in cooperation with the South Florida Regional Planning Council and continue operation of the Brownfields Revolving Loan Fund Program.
- Implement the Council's Regional Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy Plan.
- Participate in a Regional Coalition and Advocacy for Protection and Restoration of SE Florida's Nearshore Reef Systems.
- Implement the new Three-Year Economic Development Administration Planning Grant to continue Council's long running Economic Development programs that make local governments stronger and more entrepreneurial.
- Implement the new Two-Year Economic Development Administration COVID-19 supplemental grant, including hiring a dedicated Disaster Economic Recovery Coordinator.
- Continue Council's Local Comprehensive Plan Review and Technical Assistance Program.
- Continue Council's long-standing Emergency Preparedness Programs: First Responder Training, Hazardous Materials and Waste Planning and Site Registration, Local Emergency Planning Committee, Small Quantity Generators, and Emergency Preparedness Planning and Exercises.
- Along with all ten regional planning councils, update the Statewide Regional Evacuation Studies under the funding agreement with the Florida Division of Emergency Management.
- Strengthen Council's Community Visioning and Redevelopment Program:
  - Comprehensive Plan and Land Development Regulation Clarification Assistance for six Martin County CRAs.
  - FEC Railway Quiet Zone Designation Assistance for Local Governments in northern Palm Beach County.
  - Riviera Beach CRA Plan Update and associated Water Quality, Signage, Ocean Mall, and Multi-modal Transportation components.
  - Delray Beach CRA Plan Update.
  - Master Plan for 1,200 acres in Port St. Lucie's Southern Grove "Jobs Corridor."
  - Economic Analysis and Development Planning for State Road 7 and the Mall at Wellington Green in the Village of Wellington.
  - Urban planning for the City of Stuart US 1 Corridor and Gateway Triangle.

- Expand and Strengthen Council's Working Relationship with South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA), Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), and Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency (PBTPA).
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Year of latest Three-year Technical Assistance Agreement with PBTPA
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Year of latest Five-year Technical Assistance Agreement with SFRTA
  - 5<sup>th</sup> Year of Five-year Technical Agreement with FDOT District 4
- Continue to be an Outlet for Information, Education, and Regional Advocacy for Implementing the Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan.
- Build on the results of the Biosolids Summit for the Treasure Coast Region held on June 8, 2018 in partnership with the Indian River Lagoon Council, Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Florida Farm Bureau Federation, and local government utility and solid waste authorities.
- Continue exploration of the US Highway 27 Multimodal Corridor concept.
- Continue the Education Program emphasizing Traditional Town Planning and Preferred Development Patterns.
- Facilitate Port St. Lucie Development Review Stakeholder Meetings.
- Provide technical assistance for local governments in the Region concerning the 2020 Census.
- Assist with implementation of the Lake Worth Road Complete Streets study.
- Complete the study of potential lane re-purposing on US 1 in North Palm Beach.
- Complete a Multi-Modal Circulation Plan for the Indian Trail Improvement District.
- Organize and conduct a virtual joint meeting on October 16, 2020 between the Treasure Coast and South Florida Regional Planning Councils and reach consensus on critical issues affecting Southeast Florida. The meeting produced the following:
  - Resolution TCSF #20-01: Coral Reef Disease Intervention and Restoration
  - Resolution TCSF #20-02: Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Investment
  - Resolution TCSF #20-03: Biosolids Management Awareness and Pilot Project Funding
  - Resolution TCSF #20-04: Full Appropriation of State and Local Housing Trust Funds for Housing
